

WORLD LANGUAGE EXPECTATIONS

BE RESPONSIBLE* ABOUT HANDING IN YOUR WORK AND GETTING YOUR ASSIGNMENTS (please note numbers 4, 5, 6 & 7)

1. Cell phones, iPods and other electronic devices must be off and kept in your bag or they will be taken away. Your parents will be contacted as well.
2. Collaborative working does not mean that you and your partner/s turn in identical work. A zero grade will be assigned to all parties unless the group has worked on a skit together.
3. The use of **any** translating assistance, including a person or electronic device is prohibited. A zero grade will be given to the assignment.
4. ***No** late homework will be accepted unless you have an **excused** absence.
5. ***In the event of a field trip, school event, or sporting event your work must be handed in ahead of time. You will get a zero if it is not turned in the day of the activity.**
6. ***If you are absent the entire day when an assignment is due, you are responsible for getting it to me the next Spanish class you attend. It is not my responsibility to remind you to give it to me.**
7. ***If you are in school when an assignment is due but leave the building before class, you are responsible for getting me the assignment **before** you leave. Put my name on it and give it to a secretary to put in my mailbox (faculty names are above the boxes).**
8. You are expected to speak in the target language to the best of your ability.
9. You are expected to keep your binder organized.
10. You are expected to review and study 15 minutes every night.
11. You are expected to get help immediately (preferably from your teacher) if you are having difficulty at any time.
12. You are expected to keep your book covered at all times.
13. Seniors will continue to work up to and through the last day of class in June!
